



RoHS Declaration of Conformity

Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of June 08, 2011 (amended with the Delegated Directive EU 2015/863 of March 31, 2015) regulates the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS directive).

Batteries and accumulators do not fall under the categories mentioned in this directive. The Battery Act (BattG) applies to these products.

We hereby confirm that according to the current state of knowledge, all products sold by PSE Elektronik GmbH (unless expressly marked) comply with Directive 2011/65/EU and the extension 2015/863. These products meet the current requirements of the RoHS directive for all 10 named materials.

Max. 0.1% of the weight in homogeneous material for:

- Lead
- mercury
- hexavalent chromium (Cr6+)
- polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)
- polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
- Diphthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

As well as max. 0.01% by weight for cadmium.
